Yardage markers – Make sure all markers are present, clean, and legible. Repaint or replace when necessary

Maintain and repair all bridges, bow racks and benches

Pick up litter.

This work should be very easy on everyone, please pull your own weight.

Any and all work must be done with in two weeks of notification that your target is in need of work.
